**Terms & Conditions**

**Definitions:**

**Exhibitors** – Exhibit owners, their agents, employees, drivers and assistants, whether formally employed or not and including any volunteers.

**Exhibit**- Any vehicle or other object registered to attend the event.

**The organiser**- Rotary Club of Hebden Bridge.

**The rally field** – Calder Holmes Park, Hebden Bridge.

**The rally** – The entire event

**Terms and Conditions for Entering an exhibit**

All exhibitors, while at the event shall be subject to the rules and regulations of The Rotary Club of Hebden Bridge, as interpreted by the Organiser and the appointed marshals

Exhibitors must have valid third-party insurance and any relevant MOT certification for their exhibit and ensure that any drivers of the exhibit are fully competent to drive it, and have a valid and appropriate licence, and be qualified to drive or handle the exhibit or entry. Exhibitors should advise their insurers that their vehicle is being exhibited.

Exhibitors and their property, including vehicles and personal effects, will be allowed on the rally field at the exhibitor's own risk. Exhibitors will indemnify The Organisers in respect of all risks, including but not limited to, risk of fire, flooding, loss through damage, theft or accident to their property, whatever the cause during the rally, or during the setting up or dismantling of the rally or at any time the Exhibitor's property is on the rally field. Exhibitors are responsible for their own personal effects throughout the event.

Exhibitors must further agree to indemnify and hold The Organiser its members, agents and officials free from any claims that may be made by a person claiming that their loss or injury has been caused by them or persons under their direction or by their vehicles or equipment, whatever the cause, during the rally, or during the setting up or dismantling of the rally or at any time their property is on the rally field.

No trailers, towing vehicles, transporters etc will be allowed on the rally field and no parking is provided for them. Exhibits not arriving under their own power must be unloaded outside the rally field, in a safe area where they do not obstruct traffic or endanger pedestrians.

Exhibitors must not engage in any commercial activity from their allocated position or by roaming the site selling or promoting goods or services, without the prior permission of the organisers.

Exhibits left unattended **MUST** be left securely braked and immobilised (not running & ignition keys removed) and all Working entries and exhibits must be in safe working condition.

A maximum speed of 5MPH shall apply to all moving on the rally field.

All Exhibitors must obey marshals' instructions and not inconvenience or endanger any persons or animals on any part of the rally field. All entries to the Rally are accepted at the organiser's discretion and the organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any exhibit and or exhibitor who fails to comply with a marshal or other person acting on behalf of the organiser.

Entry fees are non-refundable.

The organisers may include details of exhibitors and their vehicles in a variety of rally publications, including press releases, websites and social media. Exhibitors may request that their name is not included in such publications.

To guarantee a place on the rally field, pre-booked exhibitors must be on the rally field by 11.30am and should remain there until 4.30pm.

Judging will be by a panel selected by the organisers and all decisions will be final.

Nothing in these conditions is to be taken as relieving or excusing the exhibitor, their agents or employees, from any legal duty or responsibility.
